The three math tracks have an increased emphasis on algebra skills because technical, community and four-year universities are demanding that students be stronger in this area. Students must receive a C or higher to continue on to the next course. If they receive a lower grade, but still want to continue to the next course, remedial work or a summer course must be completed to demonstrate competency to move on to a more difficult class. At semester, if a student is failing and it is determined to be a result of lack of inability to comprehend the material, we will reassign the student to a different math course. If the failure is a result of lack of effort then the student will continue in the yearlong course.

Lynden Christian High School requires all students to complete 6 semesters of math. The minimum requirement for four-year universities is three years with many schools recommending four years of math.
