To honor his service and devotion to law enforcement the FOP Lodge 24 is proud to announce a scholarship for those wishing to pursue a career in law enforcement or criminal justice.

#### The Award

There will be one, non-renewable, \$2000 scholarship available each year. The applicant must be attending, or enrolled in, a Washington State College or University on a full time basis for the 2012-2013 academic years. The applicant must be pursuing a career in, or related to, law enforcement.

The candidate shall submit the following with the application:

- 3 letters of recommendation (See application form for source information)
- A 500-word (min) essay on "How I can make a difference in Law Enforcement"
- Your high school transcripts, or if already in college, both high school and college transcripts.

#### Application and Award Dates

- Acceptance of applications will be open January 12, 2012 and close on March 31, 2012.
- The FOP Scholarship Committee will award scholarships in September of each year.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Scholarships will be issued to the recipient's selected college for use in tuition and/or related college fees
