Dear Eighth Grade Students and Parents,

Lynden Christian School is blessed by presently having four scholarships available to students who will be attending Lynden Christian High School. The names of the scholarships, the amounts, the application process, and selection procedures are listed below. (The Bill De Beeld Memorial Scholarship is available to all LCS students entering grades 1-12.) If you wish to apply for these scholarships, please follow the process and procedures indicated below.

Scholarship Titles:

The Class of 1952 Scholarship	One \$100 tuition scholarship
Peter Hoekema Memorial Scholarship	One \$350 tuition scholarship
Bill De Beeld Memorial Scholarship	Two \$500 tuition scholarships
Faye Rutgers De Boer Memorial Scholarship	Two \$550 tuition scholarships

Application Process:

The student must write a 100-150 word essay on the topic: "Why I Wish to Attend Lynden Christian High School." ***This essay and the "Scholarship Application Form" must be returned to the Middle School office in a sealed envelope by March 15.***

Selection and Notification Procedure:

An evaluation committee comprised of the Middle School principal, two Middle School faculty members, and a member of the Board of Lynden Christian School will evaluate the essays and applications. (The Faye Rutgers De Boer and Bill De Beeld Memorial Scholarships require that a member of the families also be involved in the selection process for those scholarships.) Applications will be evaluated on the basis of the content of the essay, the student's attitude, effort, and positive Christian citizenship, as well as family financial need.

The selections and notifications to the recipients will be made by June 30. The scholarship will be applied to the recipient's tuition in April of 2013. Only one scholarship will be awarded per student.
