Description

This scholarship was established in the name and memory of Clarence and Cornelia Ludden. The Luddens lived in the Lynden community from 1936 until their deaths in 1983 and 1989. Never having children of their own, they made it a priority to take interests in other's children. They left their entire estate for a scholarship to benefit the youth in Lynden for generations to come. There are **two scholarship types**: 1) Vo-Tech or two-year non-transfer community college program; 2) Four-year or two-year transfer degree. At least three scholarships will be awarded to students entering a vocational or technical program.

-Must be planning to enroll full time in an accredited vocational program, two year or four-year college/university
