#### INTRODUCTION

Thank you so much for your donations to Second Chance that will go to benefit Lynden Christian Schools. We cannot thank you enough for remembering us during this time. With COVID 19 established in our county and local community, the health of our volunteers, employees, customers and you, our donors, is our number one priority at this time. We appreciate your patience as we work through how to do this as efficiently as possible.

#### **GUIDELINES**

- 1. If you have had or have been in contact with anyone with COVID19 in the past 14 days we are unable to accept your donations at this time.
- 2. If you have a fever, sore throat, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle aches, or new loss of taste or smell we are unable to accept your donations at this time.
- 3. When you arrive please do not exit your vehicle until you are the first car in line.
- 4. We will need to keep a social distance of 6 feet when you arrive.
- 5. We will be unable to touch your donations upon intake so please be sure that you have enough help to be sure it can be unloaded safely.
- 6. Please prepare and package donations in totes and boxes that can be left here and opened for check in. No loose donations will be accepted at this time.

#### WHAT CAN WE TAKE AT THIS TIME

### As always we take items in good working condition that are gently used or new:

- -Quality household and office furniture
- -Housewares
- -Toys and Collectibles
- -Jewelry

Due to us having no outlet for items we cannot sell we have implemented some temporary intake policies:

TEMPORARY CLOTHING INTAKE POLICY – we are only able to accept 30 ITEMS TOTAL per customer of clothing, shoes and purses

- All clothing shoes and purses must be in new or very gently used condition, completely free of stains, holes, pills, and have all complete and working parts (zippers, buttons, etc..)

TEMPORARY LINEN INTAKE POLICY – we are only able to accept 1-13 gallon BAG OF LINENS per customer (with the exception of comforters, large pillows, etc. which will be at the discretion of the shed attendant)

#### WHAT WE CANNOT TAKE AT THIS TIME

#### Items we are NOT able to take:

- -All baby equipment
- -All blinds
- -Building materials
- -Computers, printers, phones and accessories
- -Encyclopedias, textbooks, & magazines
- -Hardwired lights
- -Large exercise equipment & golf clubs
- -TV's & large appliances
- -VHS & cassettes
- -Outdated, broken or dirty items
