

Cleaning: The custodial staff will clean and disinfect the classrooms, offices, bathrooms, hallways and other common areas prior to the start of the school day. They will monitor, clean and disinfect as necessary those areas during the school day, and clean and disinfect when addressing incidents that require extra attention; cleaning up vomit, urine, feces, and other infectious materials/fluid.

Disinfecting: As part of the cleaning/disinfecting process, the custodial staff and others will utilize H2Orange2 Concentrate 117, a hydrogen peroxide-based EPA-registered sanitizer and virucide cleaner that kills 99.99% of common bacteria and specified viruses. It will be dispensed from a spray bottle with pre-mixed H2Orange2 solution.

HVAC Systems
