

Lynden Christian Board of Directors Summary – Aug. 6, 2021

After Jon's opening prayer, the board reviewed how emails we receive from society members should be processed, both incoming and outgoing. There was a review of procedures and bylaws in place confirming minutes of Board meetings are to be private, as they often contain discussion of a personal nature. Once minutes are approved they are distributed to board members and a summary is posted in the Home Bulletin. There was discussion on how to proceed with our response to the masking mandate and potential correspondence to County Health officials.
