Doug Ericksen was born and raised in Whatcom County and served Whatcom County's 42nd Legislative District for 23 years. While serving our community, he remained focused on his core values of family, community, education, outdoor adventure, faith, and love of our country. Two scholarships of at least \$1,000 will be awarded to graduating Whatcom County students (one 4-year college, one 2-year college/technical college). Doug passed away in 2021 and this scholarship was created to honor his legacy and value.

- Be a well-rounded individual, exceling in the classroom and beyond
